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Information Notice 17-064, dated November 28, 2017 informed counties and primary prevention service providers that the Department of Health Care Services, Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Program, Policy and Fiscal Division, Policy and Prevention Branch (PPFD-PPB) will terminate the California Outcomes Measurement Service for Prevention (CalOMS Pv) as of December 31, 2017. The Information Notice included a list of recommended standard reports that counties can choose to run for data archival purposes.

Since the release of the Information Notice, the CalOMS Pv system has been permanently taken offline, sooner than expected. The Primary Prevention SUD Data Collection and Reporting Service (PPSDS) team has requested and is awaiting the arrival of the data that existed in CalOMS Pv. Once received, the data will be downloaded to an online repository. To minimize hardship to the counties, the PPSDS team will extract the historical data and make it available to each county in the form of the standard recommended reports. This means that each county is no longer responsible for downloading and saving the list of recommended reports. The end of March 2018 is the initial timeframe to complete the process to create the online repository, run the reports and e-mail the information to counties.
